## ENTERING ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) CREDIT TO SATISFY CSU GE REQUIREMENTS

PLEASE CHECK THE CAMPUS CATALOG OR SPEAK WITH THE CAMPUS OFFICE OF ADMISSION FOR INFORMATION ABOUT HOW ADVANCED STANDING CREDIT EARNED THROUGH ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP), INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) OR COLLEGE LEVEL EXAMINATION PROGRAM (CLEP) CAN BE APPLIED TO THE CSU GE REQUIREMENTS IN AREAS A1, A2, A3, AND B4. IF APPROPRIATE, ADD THE CREDIT IN THE FOLLOWING MANOR.

- CLICK ON THE "ADD" BUTTON FOR THE APPROPRIATE GE SUBJECT.
- IN THE NEW WINDOW, SELECT ONE OF THE COLLEGES THAT YOU HAVE ATTENDED FROM THE COLLEGE DROP DOWN LIST, PICK A TERM AND YEAR, AND THEN CLICK ON THE [NEXT] LINK.
- IN THE NEXT WINDOW, THEN:
  - o If you selected a California Community College (CCC), click on the link "Click here if your course is not in the list below". On the pop up window in the "Department/Course number" block, enter "AP Exam". In the "Title" block, enter "AP credit" and the exam title (i.e., AP credit BC Calculus). In the "Unit value" block, enter "3". Select the "semester" term type and enter the value "Pass" in the "Grade" block.
  - o If you selected an institution other than a CCC, in the "Department/Course number" block, enter "AP Exam". In the "Title" block, enter "AP credit" and the exam title (i.e., AP credit BC Calculus). In the "Unit value" block, enter "3". Select the "semester" term type and enter the value "Pass" in the "Grade" block.
- SELECT THE [ADD COURSE] LINK TO ADD THIS COURSE TO YOUR APPLICATION PAGE.

## The CSU Mentor Express Application Mode Key Points to Remember

Once you submit your first application, you can now apply to multiple campuses quickly and easily!

- Screens 2 through 12 will now be auto-populated. The data will be retrieved from your most recently submitted application.
- The Express Mode is only applicable for the same admission application cycle (i.e. 2013-2014).
- You have 90 days from your last submitted application to use the Express Mode.
  - o Why, you may ask? After 90 days, it is unlikely that your information will remain the same when you apply again.
  - o Will your basic data still be saved? Absolutely! You just won't be able to use the Express Mode.
  - Will you be able to EVER use Express Mode again? Yes! You will have to repeat the above process to regain access to this mode. Submit your initial application, then voila!
- What is NOT part of the Express Mode:
  - Supplemental questions this will remain in the Standard Mode.
  - o EOP Application this will remain in the Standard Mode.
