



Foundation Grant Guidelines

WHAT ARE FOUNDATION GRANTS

Glendale College Foundation's mission is "to raise funds to support GCC facilities, programs, and students, and to build public awareness of the college." This will be the forth year that grants are available for college projects through this Grant Program. This program is in addition to other money that is distributed to the college each year through a variety of programs.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR A FOUNDATION GRANT

Any staff or faculty member may apply.

WHAT TYPE OF GRANT IS FUNDED?

Every grant application that meets the criteria below is considered.

WHAT ARE REQUIRED CRITERIA?

- The project will make a significant impact on the college
- The project is consistent with the college's Education Master Plan (www.glendale.edu)
- Other funding sources are not available, or if other funding has been awarded, a gap still remains to be filled.

AMOUNT AND TERMS OF THE AWARD

The grants awarded will be \$5,000 and above. The total amount of dollars to be awarded is tied into our fundraising success.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- All grants to be submitted by May 30.
- The Foundation Grant Review Committee will meet over the summer and make their final determination by July 31.
- All successful applicants will be notified by September/October.
